CITY TO HOST PUBLIC PRESENTATIONS OF RONSTADT TRANSIT CENTER DEVELOPMENT PROPOSALS, JULY 22, 5 P.M.

The City of Tucson will host public presentations of the two proposals for the Ronstadt Transit Center Joint Development Project, with an opportunity for the public to ask questions and fill out comment cards. The Alexander Company/Oasis Tucson and Peach Properties each will present a design concept for mixed-use, development, with transit, to be located on the 4.7-acre City-owned site. The two presentations will be held on Wednesday, July 22, at the Tucson Convention Center (TCC), 260 S. Church Ave., in the Mohave and Maricopa Rooms. The first presentation will be held from 5-6:30 p.m. and the second from 7-8:30 p.m. Free parking will be available in Lot A at the TCC. The proposals being presented are in response to a Request for Proposal (RFP) from the City of Tucson, the second in a two-step process to select a developer for the site. The RFP includes a set of goals developed with stakeholders representing neighborhoods, bus riders, downtown businesses, and other interests.

After the presentations, both developers will have an opportunity to revise their proposals based on comments received. A selection committee made up of City staff, professional experts, and stakeholder representatives will review the final proposals and make a recommendation to the Mayor and Tucson City Council as to whether a team should be selected to enter into a final development agreement. The presentations will be the only opportunity for the public to comment prior to Mayor and Council consideration.
