### **VICE MAYOR UHLICH AND CONSTABLE BERNAL HOST SHRED-IT SERVICE AT SACRED HEART CHURCH**

Vice Mayor Karin Uhlich and Pima County Constable Bennett Bernal are partnering to host a Shred-It event to benefit Emerge! Center Against Domestic Abuse and Lend A Hand Senior Assistance on Saturday, September 26, 2015.

The Shred-It service will take place at Sacred Heart Church, located at 601 E. Fort Lowell Road, from 8:00 to 11:00 am. Individuals may bring two boxes of documents to be securely shredded on-site at no cost. A \$5 donation to Lend A Hand or Emerge! is requested for additional boxes.

Emerge! Center Against Domestic Abuse provides domestic abuse crisis intervention and housing, prevention, education, support, and advocacy services to anyone experiencing domestic abuse. Lend A Hand Senior Assistance, Inc. is a growing coalition of central Tucson neighborhoods, faith-based communities, and business partnerships whose volunteers provide free services to our seniors to allow them to continue to age-in-place as our neighbors.
