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PRIMARY ELECTION MAIL IN BALLOTS DUE

The City of Tucson wants to remind voters to place their ballots in the mail by Thursday, August 22, 2013 to ensure their ballots are received by the City Clerk's Office by 7 p.m. on Tuesday, August 27, 2013, which is Primary Election Day.

Those voters who do not mail their ballot in on time can drop off ballots at voting locations on Election Day, from 6 a.m. to 7 p.m. Voting locations are:

- Donna R. Liggins Recreation Center, 2160 N. Sixth Avenue
- El Pueblo Senior Center, 101 W. Irvington Road
- City of Tucson Parks and Recreation Administration, 900 S. Randolph Way
- Tucson City Clerks Elections Center, 800 E. 12th Street

There are no contested races in this year's City Primary Election for Ward 3, Ward 5 and Ward 6.

Any registered City of Tucson voter may obtain a replacement ballot at the above voting locations on Election Day upon presentation of a signed, sworn statement that their ballot was lost, destroyed or not received.
