## Meter Exemption Permit Information

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### Meter Exemption Permits

- \$150 - Monday through Friday, 8am-5pm.
- \$225 – Weekdays after 5pm and weekends
- \$325 - 24/7

Permits are available to Residents who live in a restricted parking neighborhood which include meters. These meters are clearly marked for the program and only specific residential addresses qualify. **No visitor passes are issued for the meter exemption program.**

The Meter Exemption Permit allows a resident to purchase a permit to park at specific meters adjacent to their residence without paying the meter. Resident is issued a permit based on program chosen and parks at designated meters marked with corresponding permit. Residents who park their vehicles at metered spaces outside the chosen program boundary or time frame are not exempt from violations and are at risk of receiving a citation.


All permits expire one year from when they are issued. Please note that it is the resident's responsibility to renew their parking permits every year when they are due to avoid any parking citations or late fees.

**Please note these meters can be purchased for an event or construction work. If the meters are hooded with a Red hood or a Temp no parking sign on the meters, you will need to park at another meter that has the meter exemption sticker during this time period**

### Permit Policies

- **No refunds will be issued for parking permits.**
- Permits are valid for current residents only. A permit becomes invalid when a resident moves from the address the permit is issued to.
- For neighborhoods in the 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue area, (Speedway to 10<sup>th</sup>/Stevens and Euclid to Stone) parking programs are suspended 2 times a year during the 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue Street Fair.
- Permits are issued to passenger vehicles only.
- A vehicle having 3 or more outstanding citations may result in all permits for that address being voided and/or removed from the vehicle. Permits are the property of Park Tucson and may be removed by Park Tucson staff.
- Permit holders must obey all traffic / parking codes and regulations. Having a permit only allows you to park on the street, it does not allow you to break any other parking violations, and it's the owner's responsibility to take care of any citations issued to them. - The permit must be permanently affixed to the outside of the lower left corner (Driver's side) of the rear window of each registered vehicle the permit is issued too (See example 1) Convertibles and trucks with camper shells may affix permits to lower left-hand corner (driver's side) of front windshield. (See example).
- **Do not place permits on any other part of your vehicle such as bumpers or on the side of vehicle.**
- **Failure to display permit properly may result in an \$85 citation being issued.**

### **Permit Replacement Policy**

- **Sold or Traded Vehicles:** The registrant must remove permit prior to selling or trading a vehicle. The permit must be presented to Park Tucson to receive a free replacement permit.
- **Windshield Replacements:** Permits will be replaced free of charge provided satisfactory proof is presented that the windshield bearing the permit has been replaced, such as an invoice or receipt.
- If the conditions above are not met, a fee equal to the amount of the original permit will be charged for a replacement permit.

### **To Apply**

You may apply in person at 110 E Pennington St Ste# 150, office hours are Monday through Friday 7:45 AM to 5:15 PM or you request that an application be mailed to you at the address the permit will be issued to or you may visit our web site <http://tdot.tucsonaz.gov/park-tucson>

Two proofs of residency are required, a valid driver's license, and proof of ownership (property tax ID form) or an original and current lease/rental agreement (agreement must show whether it is a month to month agreement or a fixed-term lease, the address of the rental, and contain both landlord and tenant signatures).

Please bring a copy of your current vehicle registration.

When mailing in the application, please include copies of the required documents and a check or money order payable to City of Tucson.
