

NEWLY COMPLETED PROJECTS

Currently, there are 13 shade structures over playgrounds that have been completed. Two new playgrounds have been constructed, and Clements and Archer pools have been resurfaced. San Cosme and Inn Suites segments of the El Paso Southwestern Greenway have been re-sealed.

PROJECTS UNDER CONSTRUCTION

A splash pad at Lincoln Park/William M. Clements Center is under construction and will be ready when splash pads open in April 2021. Chuck Ford Lakeside Park is receiving a new, energy-efficient LED lighting system on Field 1. A shade structure is being installed over the playground at Ochoa Park. Wright Elementary School Park, Rolling Hills Park, and Himmel park are all receiving a new playground with shade. Also, a new linear park on Grant Road adjacent to the Jefferson Park neighborhood is being constructed.
