




Join the Team


The Centennial Park Project has been designated an official *Arizona Centennial Legacy Project* by the Arizona Historical Advisory Commission and granted \$55,000 through the State Legislature. Mayor Robert Walkup said, “pocket parks like this have a great place in the neighborhood.” City Parks and Recreation supports the project, as do the El Presidio Neighborhood Association, the Arizona State Museum, the Arizona Historical Society, the Tucson Museum of Art, and the Sonoran Institute.
