



Summer Classes run May 31-July 23, 2016

Register Early...classes fill quickly!

Classes must meet a minimum enrollment by May 15, or they are subject to cancellation.

However, you may still register for a class if it has not been canceled and if space is available.

Refund Policy

The City of Tucson Parks and Recreation Department:

- reserves the right to cancel classes and KIDCO sites due to insufficient registrants or other causes beyond our control. In the event cancellation occurs, a full refund will be granted.
- requires a 24 hour notice for a refund of all qualified fees.
- requires withdrawals to be processed through Registration Services the first business day after online registration.
- reserves the right to change class instructors and KIDCO staff.
- A processing fee of 10% may be withheld.

Leisure Classes:

Withdrawals after class/session begins will be pro-rated based on the date Registration Services

(791-4877) is notified. Refunds will not be granted once half of the class/session has been completed. Supply, lab and model fees are nonrefundable.

KIDCO:

Withdrawals from a program site on or before the 15th of the current month participant is in, will be issued a pro-rated refund for that month **based on the date Registration Services (791-4877) is notified.** Withdrawals after the 15th of the current month participant is in, will not be granted a refund for that month. Pre-paid months will be refunded.

DISCOUNT PROGRAM for City Residents Only

Parks and Recreation offers a Discount Program that enables low-income residents to pay a 50% discounted fee on selected programs and 25% for selected passes.

- 50% discount applies only to Schoolzout, KIDCO, KIDCO Inclusion, In-Betweeners's Club, Junior Staff in Training, Therapeutic Recreation and Swim Lessons.
- 25% discount applies only to Center quarterly/annual passes, Swim annual pass and Senior Activity Card.
- You can apply at any Parks and Recreation office or Center. Call Registration Services at 791-4877 for more details.

To qualify for the DISCOUNT PROGRAM, **All of the following conditions must be met:**

Must be a City of Tucson resident:

ELIGIBILITY VERIFICATION

Applicants must provide TWO forms of documentation proving City of Tucson Residency

Note: Discounts expire one year from date of approved application.

1. APPLICANT IDENTIFICATION VERIFICATION:

Applicants must provide a picture ID with the same name that appears on the application. Acceptable forms may include:

- Driver License/non-driver ID card with photo
- Government issued ID card – passport, military, or tribal ID
- SunGo Card with photo
- Debit/Credit Card with photo

2. CITY OF TUCSON RESIDENT VERIFICATION:

Applicants must provide current documentation proving City of Tucson residency. Documentation should be dated within last 60 days. This must match the address provided for the application. PO Box is not acceptable for address. Name on this documentation must match ID. Documentation may include:

- Utility bill (electric, gas, water, land line phone, cable)
- Mortgage Statement/Rental lease agreement
- Military base housing letter

3. HOUSEHOLD SIZE VERIFICATION. Applicants must provide proof of the number of people residing in the household. Proof may include any combination of documents that has the names and/or number of people.

This may include:

- Previous years income tax return with W2 forms
- Insurance card/Immunization record
- Birth Certificate
- Report card/school ID/school lunch program letter
- D.E.S. Award Letter

4. INCOME VERIFICATION. Applicants must provide current/valid proof of household income, including all household members' income sources (wages, public assistance, retirement, disability, pension, veteran's compensation, worker's or unemployment compensation, child support, alimony, senior benefits, survivor benefits, etc) Acceptable proof may include:

- Previous year's income tax return with W2 forms
- Environmental Services or Water award letter (automatic qualifier)
- SunTran Transit ID with economy pass designation (E, S, D) (automatic qualifier)
- Paystub dated within last 30 days
- Unemployment check stub within last 30 days
- D.E.S. award letter – food stamps, cash assistance
- Social Security/Disability letter
- School meal program letter

SUMMER KIDCO/INBETWEENERS CLUB PAYMENT PLAN

A "Payment Plan" is now available for KIDCO/IBC clients using online registration (EZEEreg.com) ONLY.

Two payment plan options available:

1. Full payment at time of registration.

Payment example for City Residents in KIDCO program:

Session 1 Center and School - JUNE - Residents \$125

- 1/3 due at Initial Registration (\$41.66)
- 2/3 charged on May 15 (\$83.34)

Session 2 Center and School - JULY - Residents \$125

- 1/3 due at Initial Registration (\$41.66)
- 2/3 charged on June 15 (\$83.34)

Registration for both Session 1 and 2 - June and July Residents fee at Recreation Centers \$250

- 1/3 of both sessions due at Initial Registration (\$83.34)
- 1/3 charged on May 15 (\$83.34)
- 1/3 charged on June 15 (\$83.34)

The credit/debit card used at time of registration will be automatically charged for each additional payment. If your card is declined, we will attempt to contact you. You may resubmit your card or use a different card number. You may make up to two cash payments per school year and one per summer.

Summer Swim Lessons

Since summer pool hours do not begin until June 1, please register for **children's lessons** prior to summer pools opening at the preferred pool during the following dates and times. Register in person from Noon-6pm on May 25, 26, 27, 28, 29, 31 *(May 30 pools will be closed for Memorial Day)*.

After these dates you may register during recreational and family swim times at the preferred pool.

Competitive Swim League

Ages 17 and younger. Participants must be able to swim a recognizable competitive stroke one length of the pool without stopping. Swim test given the first day of practice.

- Cost: \$30 for City Resident - \$38 for Non-City Resident
- See pools offering swim teams listed on the next page.
- Fill out forms during pool hours, June 1-10.
- Swimmers who have registered with United States Swimming (USA) after August 2015 are not eligible.
- Swim championships will be held July 23.

Location: Quincie Douglas Swimming Pool, 36th St. and Kino Blvd.

Championship race: TBA (youth and adult)

Cost: \$8 per race for adults/\$3 for youth 14 and under

Registration required for each race: 6-6:30pm - **Race starts:** 7pm

- Each race is limited to the first 128 participants signed up. First come, first served. Please do not sign up friends/family.
- **Distances:** Youth, 200-yard Swim/1m Run/Adults, 800-yard Swim/5k Run
- Youth (14 and under) distance will be offered on the Monday nights listed. Youth wave will be the first wave each Monday evening. Youth are not limited to shorter distances and may complete adult distances if they choose. Youth completing at least 4 aquathlons will be eligible for championship race.
- Adults will be asked to note their estimated 800-yard swim time. To estimate, please pay a visit to your nearest pool and swim a few lengths (or 32) to get a rough idea.
- Participants under age 18 will be required to bring a parent/guardian to their first race to sign the City of Tucson waiver.
- Series Awards will be given to 1st-3rd place finishers in each age group based on five best finishes prior to championship race. Participants must complete at least 5 races to be eligible for series awards. During weeks with two scheduled aquathlons, you may participate Monday or Wednesday, but not both in the same week.
- Series Awards will not be adjusted due to cancellations of a race night due to weather or other unforeseen circumstances.
- Must participate in 4 races (3 for youth) to compete in championship race (youth and adult).

Other options: Find a partner and participate as a relay.

Synchronized Swim League

- For ages 6-17
- Cost: \$41/City Resident - \$51/Non-City Resident
- Pools offering synchronized swim teams are: Amphi, Archer, Clements, El Pueblo, Ft. Lowell, Purple Heart, Quincie Douglas and Udall.
- Beginner through intermediate levels.
- Register during pool hours, June 1-10 at City pools offering synchronized swim teams.
- Season begins June 2 and ends with the citywide water show July 16





Purple Heart Park

Purple Heart Park

Design and construction of an expansion of Purple Heart Park per the master plan included: A new parking lot (45 spaces), 10' wide jogging/walking path, new benches, 2 new children's playgrounds, new ADA access walks, landscape and irrigation.

Reid Park Zoo –Carousel

The American-made carousel features representatives from 30 different animal species. Each animal was painstakingly fabricated and hand painted. The carousel is topped by a safari-themed thatched roof that complements the foliage in the front plaza of the Zoo.

Tucson Rodeo Grounds

This project consisted of improved ADA access to the main bleacher area, including additional accessible parking. Retaining walls and new paving for a portion of the plaza area north of the arena were also included.

Reid Park Zoo – Gibbon Exhibit

This project includes the modification of the existing Sun Bear exhibit to accommodate the relocation of Gibbons.

Reid Park Zoo-Health Center

Rio Vista Natural Resource Park
