## **CONDITIONS UNDER WHICH BEER PERMIT IS APPROVED**

1. Identification is required for the purchase of a beer permit.
2. Applicant will be responsible for assuring all members of his/her party are of legal age (21) to drink beer according to Arizona state law.
3. Permit holder is responsible for conduct of group members.
4. Permit is not transferable.
5. Permit valid for date and location identified only. Not valid for entire park.
6. The permit covers a group of 100 people that will actually be drinking.
7. Applicants must retain permit and permit must be made available upon request from proper park or police officials.
8. Glass beverage containers not permitted. This includes beer containers when a Beer Permit is obtained.
9. Wine and liquor are prohibited in City parks
10. Per city ordinance #7530, it is unlawful for any person to consume or have an open container of any malt beverage within parking lots or vehicles within a city park.
11. This permit is not an authorization to sell beer. The sale of alcoholic beverages in city parks is strictly prohibited without a special event liquor license issued by the state of Arizona.
12. The volume of amplified music must be kept low enough not to disturb other park users. Music may not begin before 10:30 a.m. All amplified music must conclude by sundown.
13. Obnoxious behavior or excessive noise will not be permitted.
14. Park hours, as posted, must be observed.
15. Area must be left clean.
