### RESTRICTED ACCESS TO “A” MOUNTAIN

Sentinel Peak Park, "A" Mountain, will be closed on the following dates:

- Sunday, Oct. 23, 2016, starting at 4 p.m. on all vehicular traffic will be prohibited to allow the University of Arizona to light the "A" to kick off homecoming week. The park will re-open on Monday morning, Oct. 24, with no restrictions.
- Saturday, Oct. 29, 2016, & Sunday, Oct. 30, 2016. “A” Mountain will host the Get Moving Half Marathon which will restrict user access to Sentinel Peak Park. In order to accommodate the athletes, Sentinel Peak Road will close at 8 p.m. on Saturday, Oct. 29, and will reopen on Sunday, Oct. 30, at 9:30 a.m.
