GOOD FRIDAY PROCESSION AND EASTER SUNDAY SUNRISE SERVICE WILL RESTRICT “A” MOUNTAIN ACCESS MARCH 29 AND MARCH 31

This weekend “A” Mountain will host The Good Friday Procession (La Procecion de Viernes Santo) and Easter Sunday Sunrise Services (La Misa al Amanecer) which will restrict user access to Sentinel Peak Park.

In order to accommodate these events, Sentinel Peak Road will be closed at 3 p.m. on Friday, March 29, and will reopen for normal hours on Saturday; 8 a.m. for walking/biking and 9 a.m. for vehicles, closing at 8 p.m. Access will remain closed to vehicles until noon on Sunday, March 31.
