

BOND EXEMPTION CERTIFICATES

The Arizona Department of Revenue issues the Annual Bond Exemption certificates to eligible contractors for compliance with ARS 42-5007. This statute requires that all cities request this certificate from the taxpayer prior to issuing a building permit for all projects of \$50,000 or more in value.

These certificates are effective August 1st to July 31st. In order for a contractor to continue to qualify for this certificate, they are required to report their taxes in full and on time for 24 consecutive months (2 years).

If taxpayers don't meet these eligibility criteria, they should request a one-time bond exemption certificate from the Arizona Department of Revenue who will then fax it to the city for each project for which a building permit is being issued. Taxpayers should provide us with the project address, estimated completion date, and the value of the contract (not including land).

A one-time bond exemption certificate will be faxed to the building authority at the city to advise them that a building permit may now be issued for a project.
