Hi Daniel:

I wanted to follow-up on the discussion of the purpose statement that occurred in the last meeting (please note I am writing on my own capacity, and as someone who often works with the Sign Code). Several people in the final call to the audience objected to the removal of the word “businesses” in the statement that sought to balance the rights to convey messages through signs (Sec. 7A.1.1), and I agree with those statements. I wanted to add that I fail to understand why this purpose statement would be focused only on balancing the rights of individuals to convey messages on signs, when the vast majority of signs are erected by entities, mostly business entities. A statement that only looks at the rights of individuals does reflect the reality of who erects signs in the City.

If the word “business” is not palatable to the committee, then I would suggest they substitute it with “entity.” This will create a more inclusive and accurate purpose statement, as it includes religious and non-profit entities that also use signs throughout the City. The rights of all entities – businesses, non-profits, religious organizations – to convey messages should be considered in this purpose statement.

Thanks for all the work you and the other City staff is doing on this project. It is important and timely work, as the Sign Code is long overdue for improvement.
