Re: Restructuring the Work of the Citizen Sign Code Committee  
Date: Dec. 9, 2016

To ensure that any restructuring of the Citizen Sign Code Committee meets TRRG goals of transparency, accountability, collaboration and sensitivity to quality of life, we ask that a representative from the vicinity be included in its deliberations when the committee's agenda includes review of a specific Master Sign Program or Individual Sign Design Option application from that area. The City would ask the local neighborhood association to name that member. If the site is not within the boundaries of an active neighborhood association, the City would ask the Ward Office to name a citizen from the Ward who has knowledge and interest in land use/sign issues to serve in that role.

To ensure opportunity for further community input, TRRG asks that CSCC have the following operating guidelines:

1. No decision be made by the CSCC on the application at the meeting when the proposal is initially presented, allowing members to report back to those they represent
2. An opportunity is provided for other interested parties to attend and contribute to the discussion through a call-to-audience at the subsequent meeting prior to a decision being reached.
3. A city-paid design review professional or staff member be available at the meetings and to the neighborhood as a neutral party to answer any questions committee members or residents may have.
