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## MEETING NOTICE

The Sign Code Revision Subcommittee of the Joint Planning Commission/Citizen Sign Code Committee will hold a meeting on Revisions to the Tucson Sign Code. At its August 9, 2016 meeting, Mayor and Council directed staff to address the following items in the revision process: 1) comply with the 2015 U.S. Supreme Court decision on *Reed v. Town of Gilbert*, 2) simplify the Sign Code by integrating it into the Unified Development Code (Chapter 3 to Chapter 23b in the Tucson Code), and 3) make practical changes that modernize the Code, improve the quality of design and flexibility of the overall code, and ground it in technical standards. To that end, staff has prepared a Preliminary Draft of revisions to the Tucson Sign code for the Sign Code Subcommittee's review, discussion, and ultimate recommendations to the Citizen Sign Code Committee and to the Planning Commission.
