

New for 2005

The Breath Alcohol Section of the Crime Lab is moving to an online disclosure system for the Intoxilyzer Documents. In the process of doing this, some changes were made to the retrieval of these documents.

Starting in 2005...

- ❑ You will no longer see documents named "from date" and "to date."
For example: 2004 12-01 to 12-29.pdf.
- ❑ Each packet of documents will be named according to the date of the last monthly check OR the date the instrument was taken out of service (and we are unable to testify that it was working properly and accurately).
For example: 2005 01-20.pdf.
- ❑ **For MVD hearings for the end of December 2004 *and forward** it will be necessary to obtain **two** sets of documents to show that the instrument was working properly and accurately. You will need to obtain the packet dated before your subject test date **and** the packet dated after your subject test date.

For example:

Test Subject Date: February 16, 2005

Get documents:

2005 01-20.pdf

AND

2005 02-17.pdf

***Some hearings for December arrests will NOT require two sets.** If you see a packet formatted in the "from to" style that includes your subject test date, then use it. If not, you need to get the packet for December and the packet for January.

Just a reminder...

The TPD Crime Lab will now be storing all Intoxilyzer Records in computerized storage. We will no longer send hard copies of Intoxilyzer documents to each team location.

These documents are available:

- On the **TPD Intranet**. Go to the Resources heading and click the link that is labeled Intoxilyzer Reports. Choose the instrument and print the documents relevant to your case.
- On the **Common (S:) drive** of the TPD computer system. Open the folder labeled IntoxRecords. Choose the instrument and print the documents relevant to your case.
- **NEW!** The documents are now available on the **Internet**.

Choose the instrument and print the documents relevant to your case.
