ATTEMPT TO IDENTIFY - SEXUAL ASSAULT SUSPECT AREA OF 6TH AVENUE AND VETERANS BOULEVARD

The Tucson Police Department is investigating two sexual assaults that occurred in the same vicinity, on separate dates.

On June 27, 2014, at approximately 11:00 p.m., an adult female was walking in the 3500 block of South 6th Avenue when an unknown suspect approached her from behind. The suspect grabbed the victim by her hair and pulled her behind a business and into an alley. The suspect then punched the victim multiple times before sexually assaulting her. The suspect was described as a Hispanic or Indian male in his thirties, 5'8" tall, 150lbs, with short black hair and brown eyes.

On July 8, 2014, at approximately 6:30 a.m., an adult female was walking down an alley in the 3400 block of South 6th Avenue when she was struck from behind by an unknown male. The suspect struck the victim in the face several times causing serious injuries. The victim was then sexually assaulted by the suspect. He was described as a Hispanic or Indian male, approximately 6' tall and was seen riding a bicycle.

A composite sketch is included below. Anyone who recognizes the pictured individual or has information on these incidents is urged to contact 911 or 88-CRIME. The Tucson Police Department would like to remind the community to remain aware of their surroundings at all times and report any suspicious activity to police immediately. When traveling on foot, it is always safest to be in pairs and to travel along well-lit and well-populated areas when possible.
