ATTEMPT TO IDENTIFY ARMED ROBBERY SUSPECT 4301 EAST BROADWAY BOULEVARD

At approximately 3:15 p.m. on July 19, 2013, an unknown male suspect entered the Shell Gas Station located at 4301 East Broadway Boulevard. Speaking in both Spanish and English, the suspect demanded that the clerk give him money. He also displayed a handgun from under his jacket. After receiving an undisclosed amount of money, the male suspect left the gas station. The clerk was not injured during the incident. In reviewing the case during follow-up investigation, detectives from the Robbery Unit learned that the male suspect from this incident is similar in description to a suspect wanted in connection with other armed robbery incidents that occurred in the jurisdiction of the Pima County Sheriff's Department. They distributed a media release on July 23, 2013 with photographs of an individual, who is believed to be the same suspect.

The suspect in the Shell Gas Station incident was described as a Caucasian or Hispanic male in his early 20s, approximately 5'08" to 5'09" tall, with a thin build. He was seen wearing a black jacket and dark colored jeans or pants. He was also wearing sunglasses. Anyone having information about his identity or whereabouts is urged to call 911 or 88-Crime.
