### ATTEMPT TO IDENTIFY HIGHWAY ROBBERY INVESTIGATION

**\*\*\*UPDATE – JUNE 12, 2013\*\*\***

Robbery Detectives positively identified the female in the previously released surveillance photograph after following up on an 88-CRIME tip. Detectives located and detained 44-year old Cynthia Morgan this afternoon near South 12<sup>th</sup> Avenue and West Ajo Way. She was interviewed and subsequently arrested for 1 count of Forgery and 1 count of Fraudulent Use of a Credit Card. The investigation into the original highway robbery is still ongoing at this time. A booking photograph for Ms. Morgan is not yet available.

The Tucson Police Department is seeking the public's assistance in identifying a suspect involved in the use of a stolen credit card. The individual pictured below used a stolen credit card at the Shell Gas Station located at 3902 East Grant Road on May 29, 2013. The credit card used was taken during a highway robbery that occurred earlier in the day in the area of East Pima Street and North Alvernon Way.

The suspect was described as an African-American or Indian female, 5'05" tall, 220 pounds, black hair, with a tattoo on her right wrist. She was wearing a red shirt with the word "CATS" on the front of it. Anyone with information is urged to contact 911 or 88-CRIME.
