ATTEMPT TO IDENTIFY - ARMED ROBBERY SUSPECTS 10 WEST FORT LOWELL ROAD

On October 5, 2013, at 2:07 p.m., officers from Operations Division West responded to report of a beer skip and possible stabbing at the Circle K located at 10 West Fort Lowell Road. Upon arrival, officers located an adult male who had been assaulted, but not stabbed. He had minor injuries as a result of the incident. The two suspects fled the scene prior to police arrival. No one else was injured during the incident.

Officers determined that below pictured suspect entered the Circle K and took two 30-packs of beer from the cooler and exited the store without paying for the items. A customer went after the suspect and confronted him outside the store. The suspect then pulled out a kitchen knife and swung it at the customer. As the customer retreated, he was attacked from behind by a second suspect. The original suspect then assisted in assaulting the customer. A Good Samaritan grabbed a large rock from the ground and confronted the suspects, who then ran from the scene.

The first suspect was described as a Hispanic male in his 20's. He was wearing a red baseball cap and a red short sleeve polo shirt over a white t-shirt. The second suspect was described as a Hispanic male in his 20's with a small build and wearing all black clothing. Detectives would also like to identify and speak with the Good Samaritan who helped the customer as he was being assaulted. Anyone with information is urged to contact 911 or 88-CRIME.
