### ATTEMPT TO IDENTIFY SEXUAL ASSAULT SUSPECT

Between January and April of this year, a series of sexual assaults have occurred in the area of 22<sup>nd</sup> Street and Craycroft Road. There have been five reported incidents during this time frame, and it is believed that the assaults are possibly related. The victims in these incidents were all female and the attacks occurred late at night between the hours of 11:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m. In four of the five cases the suspect was armed with a weapon. Each incident occurred outdoors while the victims were walking alone in the area.

All five victims have described the suspect as a light skin Hispanic or Caucasian male, 25 to 30 years old, 5'04" to 5'06" tall, thin build, 110 to 140 pounds, short brown hair, light mustache with acne or pock marks on his face. A composite sketch is included below. Anyone who recognizes the individual below or has any information on these incidents is urged to contact 911 or 88-CRIME.

The Tucson Police Department would like to remind the community to remain aware of their surroundings at all times and report any suspicious activity to police immediately. If you are traveling on foot, travel in pairs or in a group whenever possible, especially in the late night hours.
