ATTEMPT TO IDENTIFY – BANK ROBBERY SUSPECT 2121 WEST GRANT ROAD

Shortly before 11:30 a.m. on August 28, 2013, officers from Operations Division West responded to the Chase Bank located at 2121 West Grant Road in response to a robbery that occurred at that location. Upon arrival, the officers determined that the suspect had fled from the scene and that there was no one injured during the course of the incident. Detectives from the Robbery Investigative Unit responded to the bank as well in order to further the investigation. They learned that an adult male suspect entered the bank and approached the teller counter. Once at the counter, he presented the teller with a note, which threatened harm and demanded money. After he was given an undisclosed amount of money, the male left the bank. He has been described as an African American male, 30 to 40 years of age, 5'08" to 5'10" tall, weighing approximately 180 to 190 pounds. He was last seen wearing dark athletic shorts with a red accent, a gray t-shirt, a dark blue pullover windbreaker with a hood, and white tennis shoes. The male also had a mustache. Photographs of the suspect, which were obtained from surveillance video footage at the bank, are included below. Anyone having information about the suspect's identity or whereabouts is asked to call 911 or 88-Crime.
