ATTEMPT TO IDENTIFY – BANK ROBBERY SUSPECT 2121 WEST GRANT ROAD

*****UPDATE – AUGUST 30, 2013*****

Detectives have arrested three men involved in the robbery of the Chase Bank located at 2121 West Grant Road. On August 29th, an 88-CRIME tip was received that identified the male in the previous released surveillance photograph. Detectives followed up on the tip and were able to positively identify a total of three suspects involved in the incident. All three were located throughout the day and arrested for their involvement. Detectives determined that 31-year old Timothy Green was the suspect who entered the bank and was seen in the surveillance photograph. His uncle, 46-year old Gabriel Green, acted as a lookout during the incident. Javohn Reece, 25-years old, drove the two suspects to and from the bank. Each was charged with 1 count of Robbery and 1 count of Aggravated Robbery. They were booked into the Pima County Jail.

Shortly before 11:30 a.m. on August 28, 2013, officers from Operations Division West responded to the Chase Bank located at 2121 West Grant Road in response to a robbery that occurred at that location. Upon arrival, the officers determined that the suspect had fled from the scene and that there was no one injured during the course of the incident. Detectives from the Robbery Investigative Unit responded to the bank as well in order to further the investigation. They

learned that an adult male suspect entered the bank and approached the teller counter. Once at the counter, he presented the teller with a note, which threatened harm and demanded money. After he was given an undisclosed amount of money, the male left the bank. He has been described as an African American male, 30 to 40 years of age, 5'08" to 5'10" tall, weighing approximately 180 to 190 pounds. He was last seen wearing dark athletic shorts with a red accent, a gray t-shirt, a dark blue pullover windbreaker with a hood, and white tennis shoes. The male also had a mustache. Photographs of the suspect, which were obtained from surveillance video footage at the bank, are included below. Anyone having information about the suspect's identity or whereabouts is asked to call 911 or 88-Crime.
