ATTEMPT TO IDENTIFY SHOOTER AT THE STANDARD APARTMENTS PARTY ***UPDATE – FEBRUARY 21, 2013***

The Tucson Police Department is happy to report that not only has the male, who fired a gun while attending a party of over 1000 people last month, been identified, but he has also been arrested and charged as a result of the investigation into the incident. After the initial media release requesting public assistance with identifying the male was distributed, the Tucson Police Department received multiple tips regarding his identification. Subsequent follow up investigation, involving continuing investigation and contact made with both his family and friends, led to his arrest. He has been identified as **Da'wan Grandville Lord, 20-years old**. On February 20, 2013, Mr. Grandville Lord contacted the primary case detective via his attorney. Then, on February 21, 2013, after communicating with the detective, Da'wan Grandville Lord turned himself in at the Pima County Jail. He was booked for one count of **Discharging a Firearm Within the City Limits, a class 6 felony**. He was booked into the Pima County Jail. His booking photograph is included below.

Stone Avenue, on the evening of January 26, 2013. Investigators believe that approximately 1000 people were attending the party when the shots were fired. Thankfully, no one was hurt as a result of the gunfire, which was believed to have been fired into the air. Some attendees at the party were able to obtain video footage of the party as well as of an individual, who was possibly involved in the firing of several shots into the air. This video footage was captured on cellular telephones. At least one video was later posted to the social media website YouTube. In reviewing the video footage, investigators have been able to capture a still image of the possible shooter (see below). The image reflects a tattoo on the side of a male subject's neck. Investigators are requesting anyone having information about the individual with this particular tattoo to please call 911 or 88-Crime.
