ATTEMPT TO IDENTIFY - BANK ROBBER 2455 EAST VALENCIA ROAD-PIMA FEDERAL CREDIT UNION

At approximately 1 p.m. on August 15, 2011, the Tucson Police Department responded to a reported bank robbery at the Pima Federal Credit Union branch located at 2455 East Valencia Road. Officers from Operations Division South made contact at the branch and determined that the suspect had fled the area after the robbery, and an area search was unsuccessful in locating the suspect. Detectives from the Robbery Unit responded to the scene to continue the investigation.

Detectives have determined that the suspect entered the branch and presented a robbery note to the victim teller. After receiving an undisclosed amount of U.S. currency, the suspect fled from the branch, and is believed to have left in a vehicle. No weapons were seen or implied during the robbery.

The suspect is described as a **Caucasian or Hispanic male, approximately 20-30 years of age, 5'7" tall and 170 pounds.** He has **very short brown hair and prominent acne scars on his face.** He was last seen wearing a **red t-shirt with "ARIZONA" across the front, blue jeans, a dark baseball cap, and had sunglasses hanging from the collar of the shirt.** The vehicle is described as a **silver passenger car.**

The Tucson Police Department urges anyone with information about this incident, or about the suspect to call **911** or **88-CRIME.**
