### ATTEMPT TO IDENTIFY BANK ROBBERY SUSPECT 1940 EAST BROADWAY

At approximately 2:22 p.m. on July 3, 2013, officers from Operations Division Midtown responded to the US Bank located inside the Safeway grocery store at 1940 East Broadway in response to a reported bank robbery incident that occurred at that location. Upon arrival, the officers learned that the male suspect involved in the robbery had fled prior to their arrival. They confirmed that no one was injured during the course of the incident.

Detectives from the Robbery Unit responded to further the investigation. They learned that an unknown male approached the teller counter of the bank inside the grocery store and presented the teller with a note. The note was threatening in nature and demanded that the male be given money. The suspect was given an undisclosed amount of money. He then exited the grocery store via the main entrance/exit doors and was last seen running in a southeast direction. The male has been described as an African American male in his mid-20s, 5'11" tall, weighing approximately 185 pounds, with a medium to dark complexion and a "goatee" style beard. He was last seen wearing a dark colored U of A t-shirt (possibly over a light colored shirt), dark colored pants, a dark colored baseball-style hat (worn backwards), and sunglasses.
