COMMUNITY SURVEY 2012

In an on-going effort to get a better sense of the needs of our community, the Tucson Police Department will be distributing a Community Survey for a period of approximately two-weeks, beginning on Sunday, December 9, 2012. At a minimum, the Tucson Police Department distributes surveys to the public every three years. The distributions will occur during or immediately after the various interactions citizens may have with members of the department. Beginning on December 9th, a citizen that has occasion to speak directly with any member of the department, such as Police Officers, Detectives, Records personnel, Fingerprinting personnel, Crime Lab personnel, Evidence personnel, etc., will be asked to fill out a survey to provide us with feedback regarding the interaction and their overall needs. Once filled out, the survey should be mailed back to the Tucson Police Department as indicated on each survey form. It is possible that the survey period may extend beyond two-weeks depending on the level of response that we get from community members. It is extremely important to the members of the Tucson Police Department that we have a good sense of the community's perceptions regarding service delivery, expectations, and needs. If you are given a survey to complete after any interaction with a member of the department, please take a few minutes to assist us by providing your feedback and mailing the survey back to us. Thank you in advance for your help with this very important project.
