DELAYED FATAL VEHICLE COLLISION 7600 BLOCK OF EAST BROADWAY BOULEVARD

On November 11, 2022, shortly after 6:00 p.m., officers from Operations Division East were dispatched to the 7600 block of E. Broadway Blvd. for a report of a two-vehicle collision involving a silver 1989 Honda Civic and a green 2015 Subaru Forester. Tucson Fire Department personnel responded to the collision scene, ultimately transporting the adult-male driver of the Honda to St. Joseph's Hospital with life-threatening injuries.

Detectives from the Traffic Investigations Unit were contacted and responded to the scene to continue the investigation. After conducting interviews and collecting roadway evidence, detectives determined that the Honda was traveling eastbound on Broadway Blvd. and attempted to make a left turn into a private drive. At the same time, a Subaru Forester was traveling westbound on Broadway Blvd. The Honda turned in front of the Subaru, causing the two vehicles to collide.

An officer from the Impaired Driver Enforcement Unit responded and determined that the driver of the Subaru was not impaired at the time of the collision. Failure to yield when making a left turn by the driver of the Honda is the major contributing factor of the collision.

On December 3, 2022, investigators from the Tucson Police Department were notified by the Office of the Medical Examiner that the driver of the Honda had passed away at the hospital from the injuries he sustained in the collision. The driver has been identified as 85-year-old **Remo Ferraro**. Next of kin was notified of his passing.

This is an ongoing investigation, and no charges or citations have been issued at this time.
