Working in conjunction with 88-Crime, a reward of up to \$26,000.00 is offered for information leading to the arrest and prosecution of the individual(s) responsible for the shooting incident. The reward money raised thus far is a result of contributions made by 88-Crime, the Arizona Attorney General's Office, the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms, and Explosives, the United States Marshal's Service, the Office of National Drug Control Policy, and various private citizens who wish to remain anonymous.
