FATAL MOTORCYCLE COLLISION NORTH KOLB ROAD AT EAST BROADWAY BOULEVARD

On May 13, 2015, just after 1:30 p.m., officers from Operations Division East responded to a report of a collision involving a motorcycle and a sedan at the intersection of N. Kolb Road and E. Broadway Boulevard. Investigation on scene revealed the rider of a 2008 Harley Davidson motorcycle was northbound on Kolb Road in the left turn lane at Broadway Boulevard, behind another vehicle. The vehicle in front of the rider made a westbound turn on the green light and the rider followed but made a U-turn. The driver of a 2011 Dodge Caliber was southbound on Kolb Road through the green light and struck the rider. The rider was wearing a helmet. The Tucson Fire Department responded to the scene and the rider was transported to Banner University Medical Center for a fractured leg. The injury was considered non-life-threatening at that time. The driver of the Dodge did not sustain any injuries.

On June 16, 2015 the rider of the motorcycle suffered complications from the injury related to the collision and was pronounced deceased. The rider has been identified as 59-year-old Ronald Sullivan. Next of kin has been notified.
