### FATAL PEDESTRIAN COLLISION EAST 22<sup>ND</sup> STREET AND SOUTH LONGFELLOW AVENUE

On March 17, 2013, at 7:58 a.m., officers from Operations Division Midtown responded to a report of a vehicle collision involving a pedestrian near the intersection of 22<sup>nd</sup> Street and Longfellow Avenue. Upon arrival, officers located an adult male pedestrian suffering life threatening injuries as a result of the collision. He was transported to a local area hospital where he succumbed to his injuries shortly after his arrival. The adult male driver and the passenger of the vehicle were not injured.

Detectives from the Traffic Investigations Division responded to continue the investigation. They determined that a 1993 Nissan Pickup was westbound on 22<sup>nd</sup> Street in the inside lane. The Pedestrian was crossing 22<sup>nd</sup> Street northbound at Longfellow Avenue. The pedestrian stepped into the westbound lane of traffic in front of the Nissan Pickup and was struck. Drugs and Alcohol did not appear to be a factor in the collision. No citations were issued. The investigation is ongoing at this time.

The pedestrian has been identified as 80-year old Hai T. Ting. The next of kin have been notified.
