FATAL PEDESTRIAN COLLISION 5000 BLOCK OF EAST SPEEDWAY BOULEVARD

The Tucson Police Department is actively investigating a fatal pedestrian collision that occurred yesterday morning in Midtown Tucson.

On April 2, 2019, at approximately 3:40 a.m., officers from Operations Division Midtown, along with members of the Tucson Fire Department, were dispatched to the 5000 block of East Speedway Boulevard for a report of a serious injury collision involving a pedestrian. Upon arrival, they located an unresponsive male in the roadway with obvious signs of trauma. Tucson Fire began rendering aid; however, the male was sadly pronounced deceased on scene. He was identified as **27-year-old Dyllan Bozora**. Next of kin has been notified.

Detectives with the Tucson Police Traffic Investigations Unit responded to further the investigation. They interviewed the driver and a separate witness at the scene. Based on interviews and roadway evidence, detectives were able to determine that a 1975 Chevrolet C10 Pickup was traveling westbound on Speedway in the curb lane. Mr. Bozora was walking westbound in the bike lane. As the pickup was approaching, Mr. Bozora stepped directly in front of the pickup and was struck by the front passenger corner of the vehicle. The driver of the pickup remained at the scene and cooperated with the investigation.

Speed does not appear to be a factor in the collision and the driver showed no signs of impairment. Detectives are continuing their investigation. Additional details will be released as they become available. No arrests or citations have been issued.
