FATAL PEDESTRIAN COLLISION 6025 EAST BROADWAY BOULEVARD

On February 20, 2016, around 1:15 p.m., officers from Operations Division East and members from the Tucson Fire Department responded to a report of a collision involving a pedestrian at 6025 East Broadway Boulevard. Upon arrival, officers located an adult female pedestrian and an adult male driver involved in the collision. The pedestrian did not display any injuries but was transported to Banner University Medical Center for evaluation due to diminished alertness. The driver of the vehicle was not injured.

Investigation on scene revealed the driver of a 2005 Nissan pickup truck was exiting the western driveway of the parking lot located at 6025 East Broadway Boulevard. The driver prepared to make a westbound turn onto East Broadway Boulevard. As he slowly pulled up to the sidewalk area, he felt a bump. The driver stopped and exited his vehicle. He found that he had struck a female pedestrian and rendered aid to her until paramedics arrived on scene. Speed and alcohol do not appear to be factors in the collision.

On February 21, 2016 the female pedestrian was pronounced deceased at the hospital. She has been identified as 66-year-old Gloria Miller. Next of kin has been notified. Detectives from the Tucson Police Department Traffic Investigations Unit were advised and have continued the investigation.
