FATAL PEDESTRIAN COLLISION EAST BROADWAY BOULEVARD AND NORTH PLUMER AVENUE

The Tucson Police Department is investigating a pedestrian collision that resulted in the death of a 6-year old boy.

On September 6, at 7:54 p.m., officers from Operations Division Midtown responded to a report of a vehicle collision involving a pedestrian on Broadway Boulevard near Plumer Avenue. Upon arrival, they located a 6-year old boy with life threatening injuries as a result of a collision. He was transported to a local area hospital where he succumbed to his injuries shortly after his arrival. The 65-year old female driver of the vehicle involved was not injured.

Traffic Detectives responded to continue the investigation. They examined evidence and spoke to the driver and witnesses at the scene. Detectives learned that the 6-year old boy was walking with his 13-year old brother on Broadway Boulevard just east of Plumer Avenue. The two attempted to cross Broadway from the south side of the street to the north, stopping in the middle universal lane. A white 2000 Dodge Durango was traveling westbound on Broadway Boulevard in the curb lane when the 6-year old attempted to cross the remaining lanes of traffic and the collision occurred. No citations were issued to the driver involved.

The 6-year old boy was identified as David Araos. Next of kin have been notified.
