FATAL PEDESTRIAN COLLISION EAST GRANT ROAD AND NORTH ARCADIA AVENUE

On June 28, 2013 at 8:11 p.m., officers from Operations Division Midtown responded to a report of vehicle collision involving a pedestrian near the intersection of East Grant Road and North Arcadia Avenue. Upon arrival, officers located a pedestrian suffering life threatening injuries. He was transported to a local area hospital for treatment. The driver of the passenger car involved was not injured.

Detectives from the Traffic Investigations Unit responded to continue the investigation. They determined that a 2001 Oldsmobile 4-door passenger car was traveling eastbound in the center lane of East Grant Road. The pedestrian was crossing Grant Road northbound at the intersection of Arcadia Avenue. The Oldsmobile struck the pedestrian. The intersection of Grant Road and Arcadia Boulevard was lit with street lamps and there was a marked crosswalk at the location. The investigation is ongoing at this time.

The pedestrian involved in this collision succumbed to his injuries on July 3, 2013. He was identified as 45-year old Eddie Sagastume. Next of kin have been notified.
