FATAL VEHICLE COLLISION NORTH GREASEWOOD ROAD AND WEST ANKLAM ROAD

*****UPDATE – SEPTEMBER 29, 2017*****

The adult male driver has been identified as **22-year-old Jordan Waddell**. Next of kin has been notified. The investigation is ongoing and additional information will be released as it becomes available.

Sergeant Kimberly Bay – September 29, 2017

On September 28, 2017, around 11:10 p.m., officers from Operations Division West responded to a report of a serious injury vehicle collision on N. Greasewood Rd. and W. Anklam Rd. Upon arrival, officers located two vehicles involved in the collision and immediately began rendering aid while summoning paramedics. Members from the Tucson Fire Department arrived on scene and resumed treatment. Sadly, one adult male driver was pronounced deceased on scene. His identity is being withheld, pending next of kin notification. His adult male passenger was transported to a local area hospital with serious injuries. The adult female driver of the other vehicle had minor injuries and was also transported to a local area hospital.

Detectives with the Tucson Police Department Traffic Investigations Unit responded to the scene to continue the investigation. They were able to determine the driver of a blue 2005 Nissan Altima was stopped for a red light southbound on Greasewood Rd. at W. Anklam Rd. The light turned green and the driver entered the intersection when she was struck by the driver of a black 2017 Infiniti SUV that was eastbound on Anklam Rd. and failed to stop for a red light.

The investigation is ongoing to determine if any other factors played a role in this collision. Additional information will be released as it becomes available.
