DELAYED FATAL VEHICLE COLLISION WEST PRINCE ROAD AND INTERSTATE 10 FRONTAGE ROAD

On January 11, 2019, at approximately 11:00 pm, officers from Operations Division West were dispatched to the intersection of W. Prince Rd and I-10 Frontage Rd reference the report of a serious-injury collision involving two pickup trucks.

Officers learned a white 1997 Ford F-250 pickup was traveling northbound on the I-10 Frontage Road approaching Prince Rd. The traffic signal was red for northbound traffic. The white pickup truck did not stop for the red light and struck the driver side of a maroon 2010 Ford F-250 pickup truck, which was traveling westbound on Prince Rd. The maroon pickup truck landed on its side, trapping a female passenger inside.

The driver of the white pickup truck was not injured and remained on scene. DUI officers responded and evaluated both drivers. It was determined the driver of the white pickup truck was impaired at the time of the collision. There were no signs of impairment on the driver of the maroon pickup truck. The driver of the maroon pickup truck was transported with non-life threatening injuries to an area hospital. The female passenger was transported to Banner University Medical Center with serious injuries. She was identified as 62 year-old **Marla Eby**. Sadly, on January 18, 2019, Marla died at the hospital due to injuries sustained from the collision. Next of kin has been notified.

At this time, no charges/citations have been issued. Detectives are continuing their investigation. Additional details will be released as they become available.
