GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF HIGHWAY SAFETY SELECTIVE TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT EQUIPMENT GRANT

The Tucson Police Department is proud to announce the acceptance of a \$58,000 grant from the Governor's Office of Highway Safety for the purchase of two fully-equipped police motorcycles.

The Governor's Office of Highway Safety is committed to its partnership with the Tucson Police Department in combating "aggressive" driving, impaired driving, occupant protection, and pedestrian and bicycle safety. The new motorcycles will allow for two officers to be trained and deployed as police motorcycle officers. These officers will be used to help the furtherance of traffic safety within the community. The Tucson Police Department is grateful to the Governor's Office of Highway Safety for its support in helping to make our roadways in Tucson safer.
