ARIZONA GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF HIGHWAY SAFETY WORK ZONE SAFETY GRANT

The Tucson Police Department is proud to announce the acceptance of a \$60,000 Work Zone Safety Grant from the Arizona Governor's Office of Highway Safety.

The grant funding will be utilized to enforce violations such as speeding, distracted driving, alcohol/drug impairment and other violations that occur around the various work/construction zones within the city. The goal is to reduce collisions and provide a safe environment for individuals working on or near our roadways. Approximately 60 deployments, both day and night, will be scheduled at different work/construction zones throughout the remainder of 2017.

The Tucson Police Department is grateful to the Arizona Governor's Office of Highway Safety for its continued support in helping to make our roadways a safer place in Tucson.
