HOMICIDE 2600 BLOCK OF NORTH COLUMBUS BOULEVARD ***UPDATE – July 15, 2011***

On July 15, 2011, members of the US Marshals Arizona WANTED Violent Offender Task Force acted on information received through an **88-CRIME** tip and located **35-year old Victoria Ann Juaregui** at a residence in the area of South Craycroft Road and East 29th Street. Juaregui was taken into custody on the outstanding warrant associated with this case without incident, and turned over to the Tucson Police Department Homicide Unit. Juaregui was subsequently charged with **one count each of 1st Degree Murder, Aggravated Assault with a Deadly Weapon, and two counts of Attempted Robbery** for her role in this incident. She will be booked into the Pima County Jail.

This investigation is ongoing and the Tucson Police Department urges anyone with information about this investigation to contact **911** or **88-CRIME**.

At approximately 1:30 a.m. on May 20, 2011, the Tucson Police Department began receiving 911 calls regarding shots heard in the 2600 block of North Columbus Boulevard. Officers from Operations Division Midtown responded to the area and located the incident scene at a duplex residence. Two adult victims were found outside the residence, both suffering from apparent gunshot trauma. A **female, approximately 45 years of age**, was found with non-life threatening injuries and transported to a local trauma center. She is expected to survive. A **male, approximately 45 years of age**, was found suffering from life-threatening injuries. Medic-trained officers immediately began to administer life-saving measures, which were continued by paramedics upon their arrival. Ultimately, the victim was pronounced deceased at the scene. Next of kin have not yet been notified.

The Homicide Unit, aided by the Night Detective Detail, responded to the scene to continue the investigation, which is in the preliminary stages. Initial information suggests that the victims, who are husband and wife, and the suspect or suspects are acquainted with each other. A motive for the crime has not yet been determined. There is no suspect information available for release at this time.

The deceased victim has been identified as **46-year old Mauro Sosa**, of Tucson. Next of kin have been notified.

Detectives have determined that the incident appears to have stemmed from a robbery or robbery attempt that escalated into a shooting. The investigation is ongoing.

Tucson Police Homicide Detectives have obtained an arrest warrant for **35 year-old Victoria Ann Juaregui** for **one count of First Degree Murder** in connection to the shooting death of Mr. Mauro Sosa that took place on May 20, 2011.
