### HOMICIDE INVESTIGATION 1901 N. WILMOT ROAD

The Tucson Police Department is actively investigating a homicide that occurred yesterday evening on Tucson's eastside of town.

On February 12, 2017, just after 8:30 p.m., officers from Operations Division East responded to an apartment complex located at 1901 North Wilmot Road for multiple reports of gunfire. Upon arrival, officers located an adult male lying in the parking lot with obvious signs of gunshot trauma. A citizen was performing CPR on the victim until officers took over medical treatment. Tucson Fire responded to assist, however the victim was pronounced deceased shortly after their arrival.

Detectives from the Tucson Police Department's Homicide Unit and Night Detective Unit responded to continue the investigation. They were able to determine that the victim was a passenger in a vehicle with two other friends. When the vehicle pulled into the complex parking lot, there was an altercation between the occupants of the victim's vehicle and the occupants of another vehicle(s). During the altercation, shots were fired and the victim was struck. The other vehicle(s) fled before police arrival. It is unknown at this time if the victim knew the suspects in the other vehicle(s).

The victim has been identified as 22-year-old Edward A. McGuire. Next of kin has been notified.

Detectives are asking anyone who witnessed the incident or saw vehicles leaving the scene, to please call 911 or 88-CRIME immediately. You can remain anonymous. Additional details will be released as they become available.
