### **HOMICIDE INVESTIGATION 1990 SOUTH CRAYCROFT ROAD**

**\*\*\*UPDATE – AUGUST 25, 2017\*\*\***

An arrest has been made in the homicide of 36-year-old Jeremy Broussard.

Homicide detectives have been gathering information and following up on leads since the incident occurred on the evening of August 18, 2017. Detectives learned that Mr. Broussard had been stabbed during an altercation in a motel parking lot located at 1990 S. Craycroft Road. As they continued their investigation, detectives were able to obtain surveillance video from the area. Images from that video were distributed to department members in an attempt to identify a possible suspect involved. Patrol officers recognized the suspect in the video as 32-year-old Marco Levonte Williams.

On August 24, 2017, patrol officers located Williams and took him into custody near his residence in the 5400 block of E. 30<sup>th</sup> Street. A search warrant was conducted at his residence and items of evidentiary value were located. After speaking with Williams, he was booked into the Pima County Jail on one count of First Degree Murder. Detectives are still asking anyone with information to please call 88-CRIME. You can remain anonymous.

The Tucson Police Department is actively investigating a homicide that occurred yesterday evening at 1990 S. Craycroft Rd.

On August 18, 2017, just before 10:00 p.m., officers from Operations Division Midtown responded to an unknown trouble call at a motel located at 1990 S. Craycroft Rd. Upon arrival, they located an adult male in the front parking lot with obvious signs of trauma. The officers immediately began rendering aid and summoned paramedics. The Tucson Fire Department responded to the scene and continued treatment of the male. He was transported to Banner University Medical Center with life-threatening injuries but later succumbed to those injuries and was pronounced deceased at the hospital.

Detectives from the Tucson Police Department Homicide Unit responded to the scene to continue the investigation. The investigation is in the early stages but preliminary information revealed the male had been in an altercation in the parking lot. Detectives are requesting anyone with information related to this incident to please call 911 or 88-Crime (you can remain anonymous).

The investigation is ongoing and additional details will be released as they become available.
