HOMICIDE INVESTIGATION 200 BLOCK OF NORTH FENCELINE DRIVE

The Tucson Police Department is investigating an apparent murder/suicide that occurred yesterday evening on Tucson's East Side.

On January 25, 2019, at approximately 4:30 p.m., officers from Operations Division East were dispatched to a residence in the 200 block of North Fenceline Drive for reports of a possible shooting. Neighbors called 911 saying they heard gunfire coming from a specific home in the neighborhood. While officers were enroute, an additional 911 call was received from a family member who advised of a possible shooting at the same address. The family member was not at the home, but had received a phone call about the incident. The caller also advised that an 8-year-old boy was possibly inside of the residence.

When officers arrived on scene, they attempted to make contact with the residents, but were unsuccessful. Members of the Tucson Police SWAT Team were also dispatched to the home. After no response from anyone inside, SWAT Team members forced entry into the home. A SWAT robot equipped with a camera was sent inside. From the video, officers were able to see what appeared to be two unresponsive adults on the floor. SWAT Team members entered the home and found an adult male and an adult female with obvious signs of gunshot trauma. Both adults were pronounced deceased on scene. As the SWAT team continued through the home, they located the child who was thankfully uninjured. He was taken out of the home and is currently with extended family members. No one else was located inside.

Detectives with the Tucson Police Homicide Unit responded to continue the investigation. They were able to determine that the couple was married and that the child was their grandson. Detectives spoke with neighbors and family members and served a search warrant on the home. Based on their initial investigation, it appears the husband shot his wife and then turned the gun on himself. At this time detectives are investigating the incident as a murder/suicide.

The deceased female was identified as **49-year-old Cindi Wiley**. The deceased male was identified as **53-year-old Andrew Wiley**. Next of kin has been notified. Anyone with additional information about this incident is asked to call 88-CRIME.
