### **HOMICIDE INVESTIGATION 2320 NORTH SILVERBELL ROAD**

On May 16, 2014, at approximately 12:25 A.M., officers from Operations Division West responded to the report of a shooting in the Famous Sam's parking lot, located at 2320 North Silverbell Road. Upon arrival officers located an adult male with obvious signs of gunshot trauma. That individual was transported to a local trauma center with life-threatening injuries. The suspect in the shooting had fled the scene prior to police arrival. Detectives from the Aggravated Assault Unit and Night Detectives Unit responded to continue the investigation. They were able to identify the shooter as 51-year old Mark Walck. On the afternoon of May 16, 2014, Mr. Walck was taken into custody after turning himself in to police. Mr. Walck was booked into the Pima County Jail for Aggravated Assault with a Deadly Weapon.

On June 6, 2014, the victim in this incident succumbed to his injuries. He has been identified as 41-year old Raul Castro Jr. Next of kin have been notified.

Additional charges against Mr. Walk are now pending. A booking photo from his May 16<sup>th</sup> arrest is attached below. Anyone with additional information about this incident is encouraged to call 911 or 88-CRIME.
