HOMICIDE INVESTIGATION 2425 NORTH ORACLE ROAD

*****UPDATE – NOVEMBER 25, 2016*****

The victim from last night's homicide has been identified as 30-year-old Adam Bourdon. Next of kin has been notified. Anyone with information is urged to call 911 or 88-CRIME.

The Tucson Police Department is actively investigating a homicide that took place yesterday evening at a motel in the 2400 block of N. Oracle Rd.

On November 24, 2016, just after 11:30 p.m., officers from Operations Division West responded to a disturbance call at a motel in the 2400 block of N. Oracle Rd. Upon arrival, officers located an adult male on the ground near the office with obvious signs of trauma and immediately summoned paramedics. Members from the Tucson Fire Department arrived on scene and began medical treatment, however the victim was pronounced deceased shortly after their arrival.

The Tucson Police Department Night Detective Unit and Homicide Unit responded to the scene to continue the investigation. The investigation is in the early stages and details are limited. However, the detectives have learned the victim had been staying at the motel for at least one day and it appears there had been some type of altercation inside his room. No suspect or suspects have been identified at this time.

Additional details will be released as they become available. Detectives are urging anyone with information to please call 911 or 88-CRIME. You can remain anonymous.
