### HOMICIDE INVESTIGATION 2700 BLOCK WEST CALLE ARANDAS

On May 24, 2013, at 1:47 a.m., officers from Operations Division Downtown responded to a report of shots fired at a residence in the 2700 block of West Calle Arandas. Upon arrival, officers located two victims suffering from gunshot trauma. The first victim, a 17-year old male, was transported to a local area hospital with non-life threatening injuries. The second victim, identified as 21-year old Miguel Altamirano, was pronounced deceased at the scene.

Detectives from the Homicide Unit responded to continue the investigation. They determined that the residents at the home were hosting a high school graduation party. An estimated 30 to 50 guests were in attendance. During the party, a physical altercation began in the front yard between the suspect and the 21-year old victim. During that altercation, the suspect produced a handgun and fired it towards the 21-year old victim and other people in the area. As a result, both victims were struck by gunfire. The suspect and his associates then left the residence in a vehicle.

During their investigation, detectives obtained an arrest warrant for 18-year old Joseph Goodman for 1<sup>st</sup> Degree Murder for his involvement in the incident. At about 4:00 p.m., U.S. Marshals took Mr. Goodman into custody at a relative's home. He was booked into Pima County Jail for 1 count of First Degree Murder and 1 count of Aggravated Assault. A booking photograph is not available at this time. Detectives still wish to speak with several other individuals that were with Mr. Goodman at the time of the shooting. Anyone with information is urged to contact 911 or 88-CRIME.
