### HOMICIDE INVESTIGATION 3925 EAST GRANT ROAD

**\*\*\*UPDATE – MAY 14, 2013\*\*\***

The Tucson Police Department is seeking the public's assistance in locating a suspect involved in the May 1<sup>st</sup> shooting death of Ricky Lomax. Detectives obtained an arrest warrant for 27-year old Jeremy Shane Davis for 1 count of First Degree Murder and 1 count of Prohibited Possessor.

Mr. Davis is an African-American male, 6'00" tall, 200 pounds, with brown hair and brown eyes. He has numerous tattoos on his neck and arms. Anyone with information is urged to contact 911 or 88-CRIME.

On May 1, 2013 at 3:50 a.m., officers from Operations Division Midtown responded to a report of shots fired at the 24-hour Walmart located at 3925 East Grant Road. Upon arrival, officers located an adult male victim inside the front doorway of the Walmart suffering from gunshot trauma. The victim was pronounced deceased at the scene.

Detectives from the Gang Investigations Unit responded as information was received that one of the parties involved may have gang affiliations. Detectives spoke to witnesses and examined physical evidence at the scene. They determined that the victim was involved in an altercation with several individuals near the front entrance to the Walmart. At least one of those individuals fired shots at the victim striking him multiple times. The victim walked through the Walmart doors into the store where he collapsed and was found by police. The suspects are possibly associated with a white 4-door passenger car that was seen leaving the area immediately after the shooting. The investigation is ongoing at this time.

The victim in this incident was identified as 25-year old Ricky Lomax, a Tucson resident. Next of kin have been notified. Anyone with information is urged to contact 911 or 88-CRIME.
