### HOMICIDE INVESTIGATION 4400 BLOCK OF EAST 28<sup>TH</sup> STREET

The Tucson Police Department is actively investigating a homicide that occurred early this morning in the 4400 block of E. 28<sup>th</sup> St.

On August 21, 2017, around 4:35 a.m., officers from Operations Division Midtown responded to a request from the Tucson Fire Department for assistance at a residence in the 4400 block of E. 28<sup>th</sup> St. reference a possible shooting victim. Officers were first on scene and located an adult male inside a residence with apparent gunshot trauma. Officers immediately began rendering aid and summoned paramedics. Paramedics arrived on scene and continued treatment of the male. He was transported to Banner University Medical Center with life-threatening injuries but succumbed to injuries shortly after arrival. The male has been identified as **33-year-old Greg Ridgley**. Next of kin has been notified.

Detectives from the Tucson Police Department Homicide Unit responded to the scene to further the investigation. They learned several individuals entered the residence and one was armed with a firearm. At some point, Mr. Ridgley was shot and the suspects fled in an unknown direction. The investigation is ongoing but this incident does not appear to be a random act. The detectives are asking anyone with information related to this incident to please call 88-CRIME (you can remain anonymous).
