HOMICIDE INVESTIGATION 7900 BLOCK EAST SENATE STREET *UPDATE – OCTOBER 23, 2013*****

Personnel working for the United States Marshal’s Service located and apprehended Antajuan Stewart Carson Junior at the residence of a family member in Detroit, Michigan on October 23, 2013. He was taken into custody pursuant to the warrant, which had been issued for his arrest. Mr. Carson Jr. will remain incarcerated in Detroit, Michigan pending extradition to Pima County. A more current booking photograph of Mr. Carson Jr. is not yet available.

Detectives have identified a suspect in the shooting that occurred on October 11, 2013 in the 7900 block of East Senate Street. *****Update – OCTOBER 14, 2013*****

The names of the deceased shooting victims from the 7900 block of East Senate Street have been released. The victim who pronounced deceased at the scene was identified as 18-year old Stanford Bell. The victim who was transported to the hospital and succumbed to his injuries there was identified as 20-year old Javohn Milne. Next of kin have been notified.

Sergeant Chris Widmer – October 14, 2013

On October 11, 2013, at 11:46 p.m., officers from Operations Divisions East responded to a report of a shooting in the 7900 block of East Senate Street. Upon arrival, officers located two adult males with gunshot trauma in the street. One of the males was pronounced deceased at the scene. The second male was transported by ambulance to a local area hospital where succumbed to his injuries shortly after his arrival. A third adult male shooting victim was driven to a local area hospital prior to police arrival. His injuries were considered serious and possibly life threatening.

Night Detectives and Homicide Detectives responded to continue the investigation. They determined that there was a party at residence on Senate Street with an estimated 40 to 50 people in attendance. A physical altercation erupted in front of the home and shots were fired. At this time, the investigation is ongoing. Detectives interviewed nearly 20 people who were in attendance at the party. However, a lot of the guests left prior to police arrival. Detectives are asking anyone with information to contact 911 or 88-CRIME.
