HOMICIDE INVESTIGATION 800 BLOCK OF WEST CALLE MEDINA

The Tucson Police Department is actively investigating an apparent murder/suicide where five individuals were found deceased inside of a residence on the south side of Tucson.

On May 12, 2015, just before 6:00 p.m., officers from Operations Division South responded to a residence in the 800 block of West Calle Medina for an "Unknown Trouble" call. Upon arrival, officers spoke with the individual who called 911. He advised police that he arrived at the residence to visit an acquaintance and noticed a deceased male inside the home when he opened the front door. Officers made entry into the home and located five bodies with obvious signs of gunshot trauma.

The individuals found inside the home have been identified as:

58-year-old Raul Carrillo
53-year-old Karen Saari
32-year-old Erik Carrillo
17-year-old Isela Rodriguez
25-year-old Christopher Carrillo

Next of kin have been notified.

Detectives from the Tucson Police Department's Homicide Unit and Night Detective Unit have been investigating the incident since yesterday evening. Their investigation has revealed that this incident is an apparent murder/suicide. Detectives believe 25-year-old Christopher Carrillo shot and killed four of his family members before turning the gun on himself. As detectives continue their investigation, more information will be revealed as it becomes available.
