HOMICIDE INVESTIGATION EAST GOLF LINKS AND SOUTH CRAYCROFT

*****UPDATE – AUGUST 23, 2015*****

As detectives continued their investigation, they were able to determine that the victim had been approached by a male and female that knew him. An argument ensued over property and a physical altercation took place. During the fight, the female suspect stabbed the victim multiple times and then fled the scene with the male suspect. The female suspect was identified as **18-year-old Trinity Corin Fowble**. On August 22, 2015 Trinity was located on a traffic stop with the male suspect. Detectives spoke with both parties involved and then booked Trinity into the Pima County Jail on one count of 2nd Degree Murder. Charges are pending on the male suspect. Detectives are still looking to speak with other witnesses who were at the scene.

The Tucson Police Department is actively investigating a homicide that took place earlier this afternoon on the east side of town.

On August 21, 2015 at approximately 12:30 p.m., officers from Operations Division East responded to the report of a stabbing in the area of East Golf Links Road and South Craycroft Road. Upon arrival, officers located an adult male in the alley, northeast of the intersection. The male had obvious signs of trauma, consistent with stab wounds. Two citizens were rendering aid to the victim. Officers took over medical treatment, using their Individual First Aid Kits (IFAK) in an attempt to stop the bleeding. Tucson Fire responded to continue treatment, but the victim was pronounced deceased on-scene shortly after their arrival.

Detectives from the Tucson Police Department's Homicide Unit and Aggravated Assault Unit responded to the scene to continue the investigation. Detectives learned that the two males rendering aid lived in the area and knew the victim. They told police that the victim approached them in the alley and advised them he had been stabbed and needed help. The two men called police and then began rendering aid.

Detectives are following up on several investigative leads at this time, but are asking anyone with information to please call 911 or 88-CRIME.

The victim has been identified as 27-year-old Nathan Olney. Next of kin have been notified.
